


2.	IMPROVEMENT Fixed an issue that sometimes caused end of placement feedback forms to appear at the commencement of a placement.											
3.	IMPROVEMENT Fixed an issue that sometimes meant shift feedback forms could not be submitted by a supervisor.											
4.	IMPROVEMENT Fixed an issue that sometimes meant a supervisor added by an admin user to an area could not be removed.											
5.	IMPROVEMENT Fixed an issue that sometimes meant a supervisor user could not be added to a student's "Default Supervisor" tab by a user with Director, Manager or Student Placement Coordinator role .
